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ABOUTLINKED UP

Q: What is LinkedUp?

- LinkedUp is a program of Teen Health
- A: Mississippi that helps young people transition to the adult healthcare system after high school.

Q: Who is it for?

Young people ages 16 to 25

- Young people who age out of Medicaid
- Young people who are going to college, entering the workforce, or joining the military

Q: What problem does it solve?

18- to 19-year olds have poorer health outcomes
compared to other young people. LinkedUp gives these young people the information they need to access healthcare as emerging adults.

How to use the LinkedUp resource guide

 - If the college you plan to attend does not have a health center on campus, refer to the Nearby Community Health Center Column or Healthcare Finder page
 - Use the information in this resource guide to help plan for your transition to the adult healthcare system

MEDICAID FAMILY PLANNING WAIVER



If you have no other health insurance you may qualify to receive limited healthcare services through the Medicaid Family Planning Waiver program

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

You are eligible for these services if:

- You are between the ages of 13 and 44.
- You are currently not pregnant.
- You do not have Medicare, Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP), or any other health insurance or third party medical coverage.
- Your family income is at or below 194% of the Federal Poverty Level.

SERVICES YOU CAN RECEIVE

HEALTH SERVICES

- An annual medical exam by a physician. This may include medical history, height, weight and blood pressure checks, and for women, a Pap smear and clinical breast exam.
- Testing for pregnancy, HIV, and sexually transmitted infections (STIs).
- Free prescription for medications to treat an STI.

BIRTH CONTROL AND FAMILY PLANNING

- Visits to a nurse or doctor related to birth control methods and family planning services
- Free prescriptions for birth control supplies and contraceptives

HOW TO APPLY

To apply for the Medicaid Family Planning Waiver program, you must complete the application form at medicaid.ms.gov and return the completed form to the Mississippi Division of Medicaid. Once approved, you will receive a yellow Medicaid card in the mail from the Mississippi Division of Medicaid.

Teen Health Mississippi is all about healthy youth and whole communities. We believe that when youth have the resources, knowledge, and support they need, whole communities can thrive.


